Marjory Warren Guest Lecture by Professor John Gladman



John Gladman is Professor of Medicine of Older People at the University of Nottingham, and Consultant in Health Care of older People and the Nottingham University Hospitals NHS trust. As an academic he is involved in a wide range of research across the spectrum from translation to implementation. As a clinician he has worked in the community as well as in a wide range of acute and sub-acute hospital settings.

Guest Lecture by Mr Peter Homa

Peter Homa has extensive healthcare management experience including 27 years as a chief executive of local and national organisations. He was appointed as Chief Executive at Nottingham University Hospitals in 2006 until he retired in November 2017.

He became a CBE in 2000 for his contribution to the health service.

Peter was one of four independent experts who helped review Robert Francis QC's final recommendations following the Mid Staffordshire Foundation Trust public inquiry. He was also a member of the Freedom to Speak Up review, also led by Robert Francis, into creating the open and honest reporting culture in the NHS. Peter is Chair of NHS Leadership Academy.
