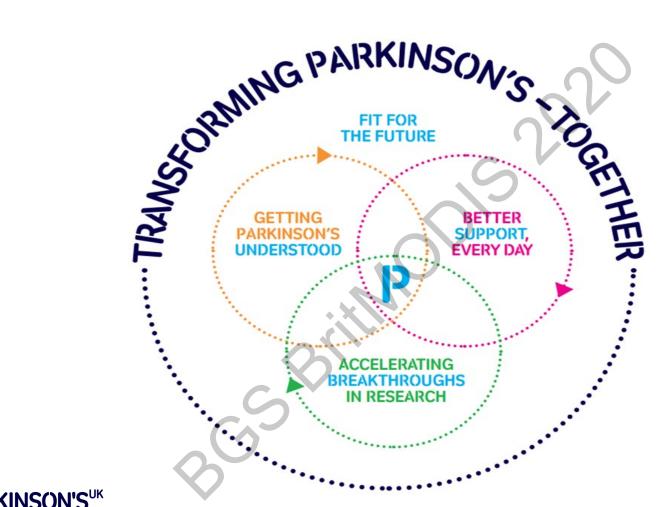

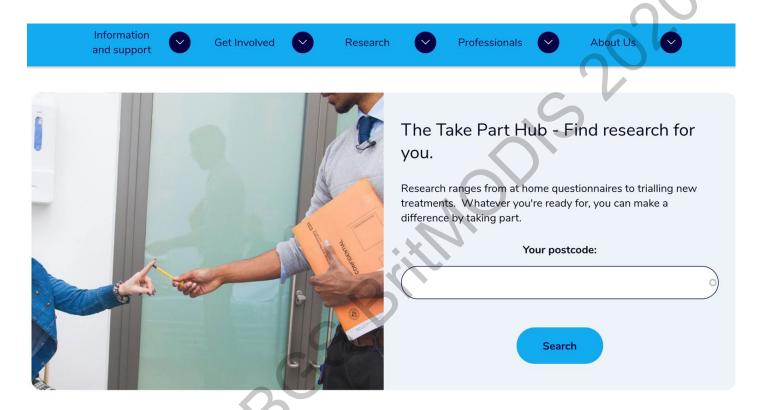
Our pioneering research programme delivers life changing new treatments for people with Parkinson's, who own and shape it every step of the way.

Connecting patients with research

In 2017 we surveyed 1526 people affected by Parkinson's. 97% said they would want to hear about opportunities to take part in research within the first year of diagnosis

700 (46%) of then said that they wanted to hear about research from you - their trusted professional - first.

Creating a new service pathway for people living with Parkinson's, their family, friends and carers

Why do we need to change?

There are four key drivers:

- 1. With an estimated 20% increase in the number of people living with Parkinson's over the next decade, our existing service models are unable to scale to meet new demand.
- 2. We want to work as effectively and efficiently as possible , whilst increasing our reach and impact. Harnessing digital technologies and new ways of working can help us achieve that
- 3. User expectation is changing and people are looking for support in different ways, we need to be able to change to be there, where we're needed
- 4. Our current services are not offering the support needed to family, friends and carers and they don't recognise us as a charity that's there for them to o

Progress to date

Discover research stage - April - Nov 2019

Collating existing knowledge and doing further research with people with Parkinson's, carers, healthcare professionals and Parkinson's UK service staff across the UK.

Shaping the outline of a new support service pathway.

Alpha testing stage - Oct 2019 - April 2020

We are testing the following elements of the new service pathway across the UK:

Direct and self referral

Service triage

Future planning specialist service

Advocacy specialist service

Account

The direct referral tool is live in **three locations** and we are testing our other service elements across a range of areas and people.

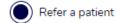

Direct Referral: what are we testing?

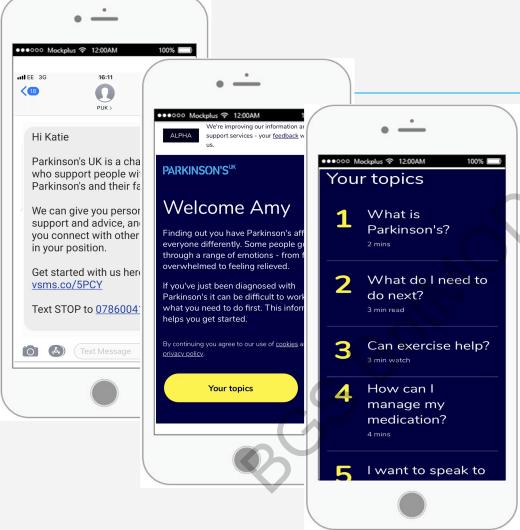
A simple online referral form for people newly diagnosed with Parkinson's and a family member or friend.

This has met governance requirements across three

Trusts and is **now live!**

We want to learn:

• Will this form and process work for consultants and Parkinson's nurses?



Direct Referral: what are we testing?

After referral people receive an SMS or email with links to content specific to the person with Parkinson's or loved one.

Print information is still supplied to all patients, whether they are referred or not.

We want to learn:

- Will people affected by Parkinson's go through the referral process?
- Will they engage with content and find it beneficial?

Scale the direct referral tool and other elements of the service pathway to

10 locations across the UK. Aiming to recruit test sites across different countries,
urban vs rural locations, and Parkinson's service models.
