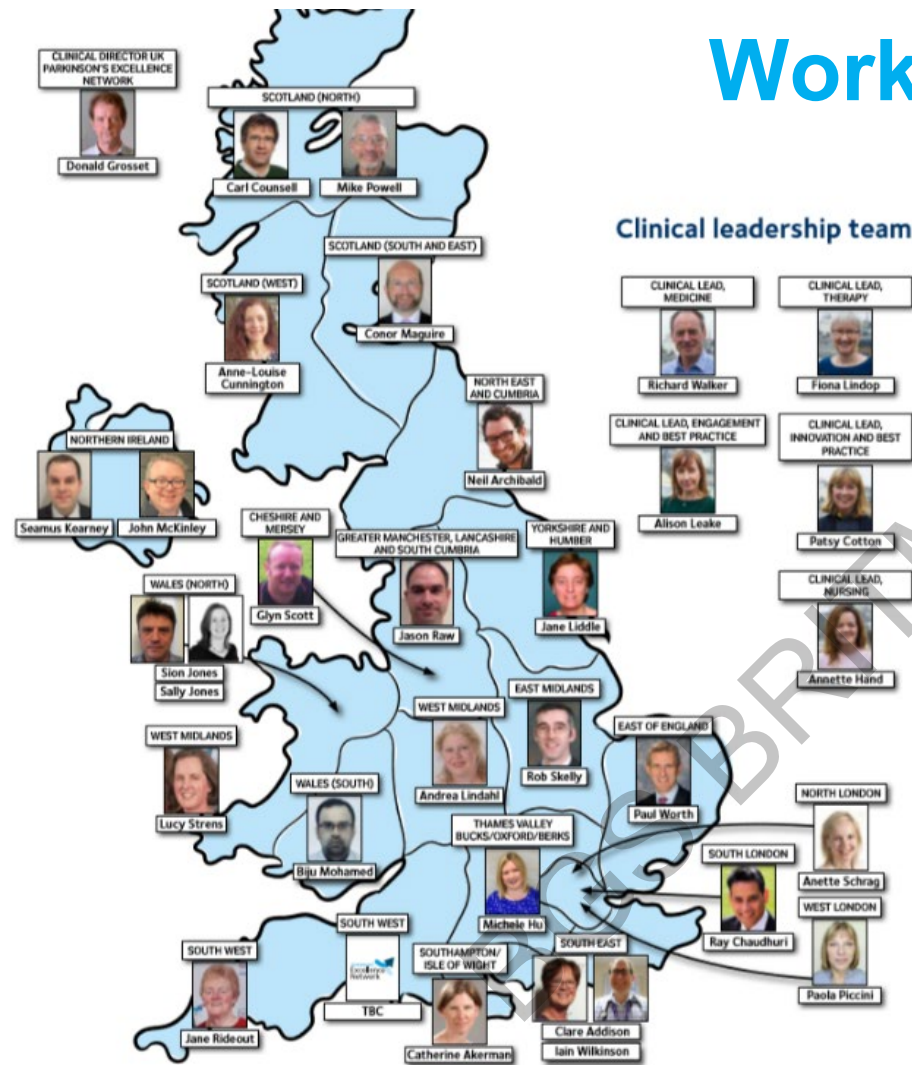
The Excellence Network is the driving force for service improvement in Parkinson's care

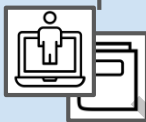

The Future Service Pathway

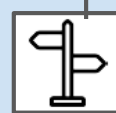

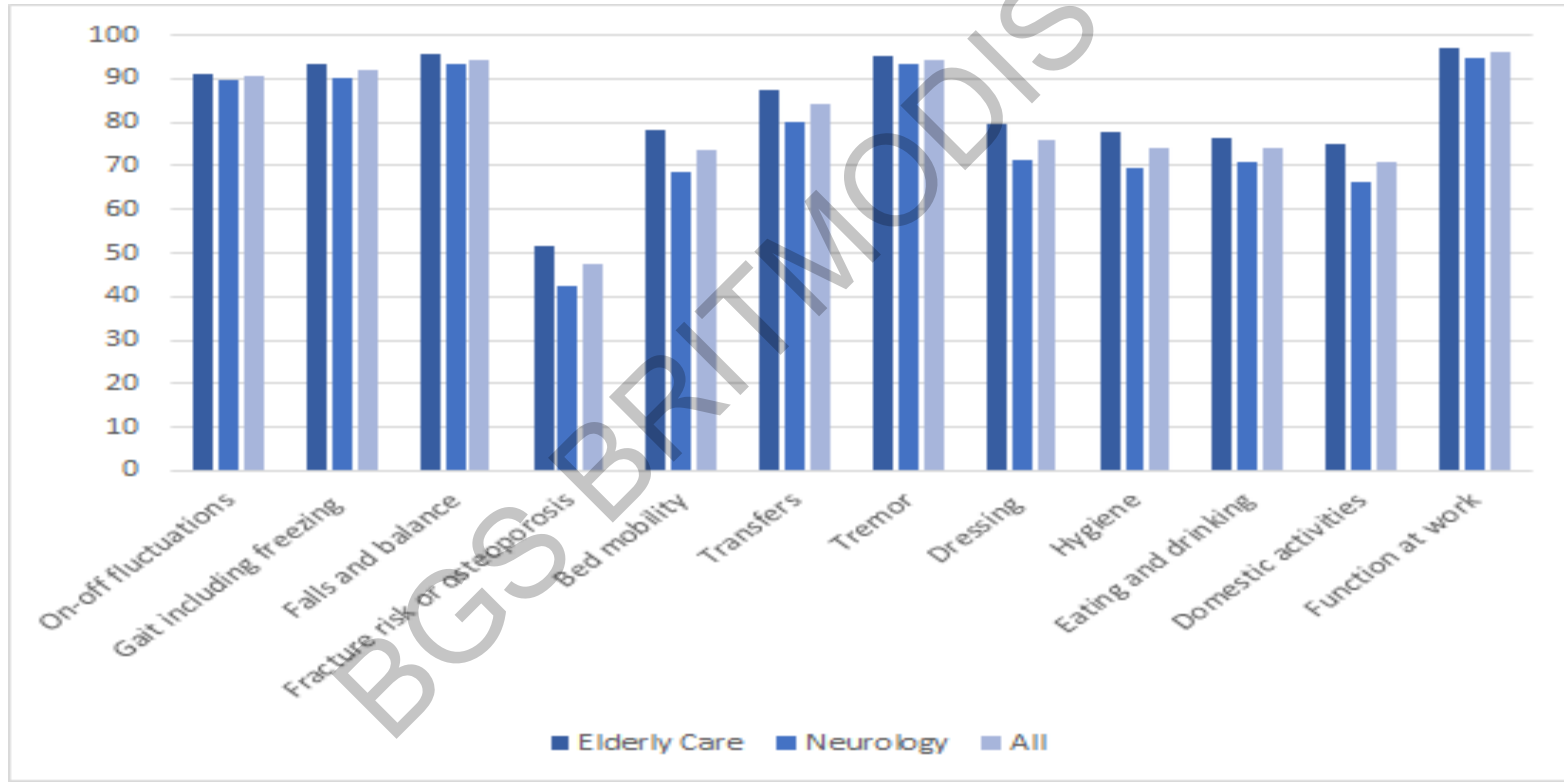

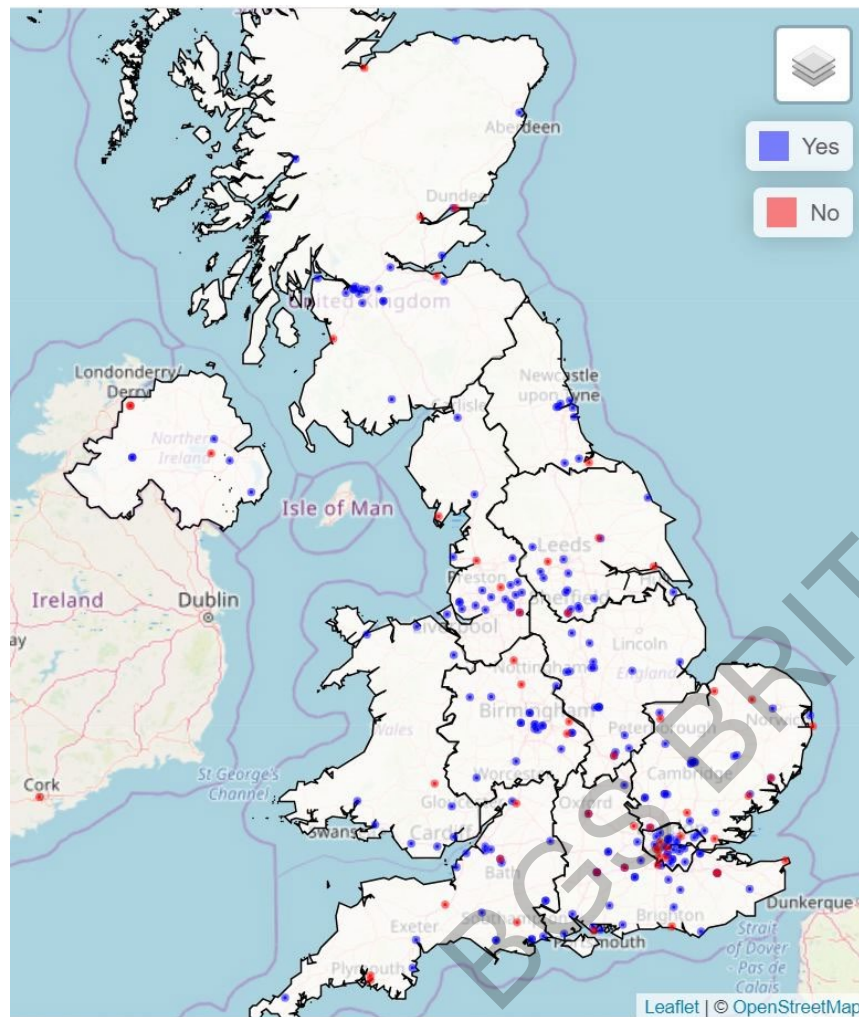
