Covid-19 impact on training

- PYAs suspended from March 2020
- The PYA is not a requirement for trainee progression to CCT
- Trainees who were due to have a PYA during the period of suspension will not be expected to undertake one if PYAs restart before their CCT date.
- Within the region, we are running "mock PYAs" for ST6 trainees to support the education process, although official guidance is that this should be done by ES

- Requirement for Palliative medicine trainees to take part in IM rota
- Geriatric medicine trainees will need to gain palliative medicine experience - current suggestion is 4 week attachment undertaken during final two years of training. Possible OOP for greater experience
