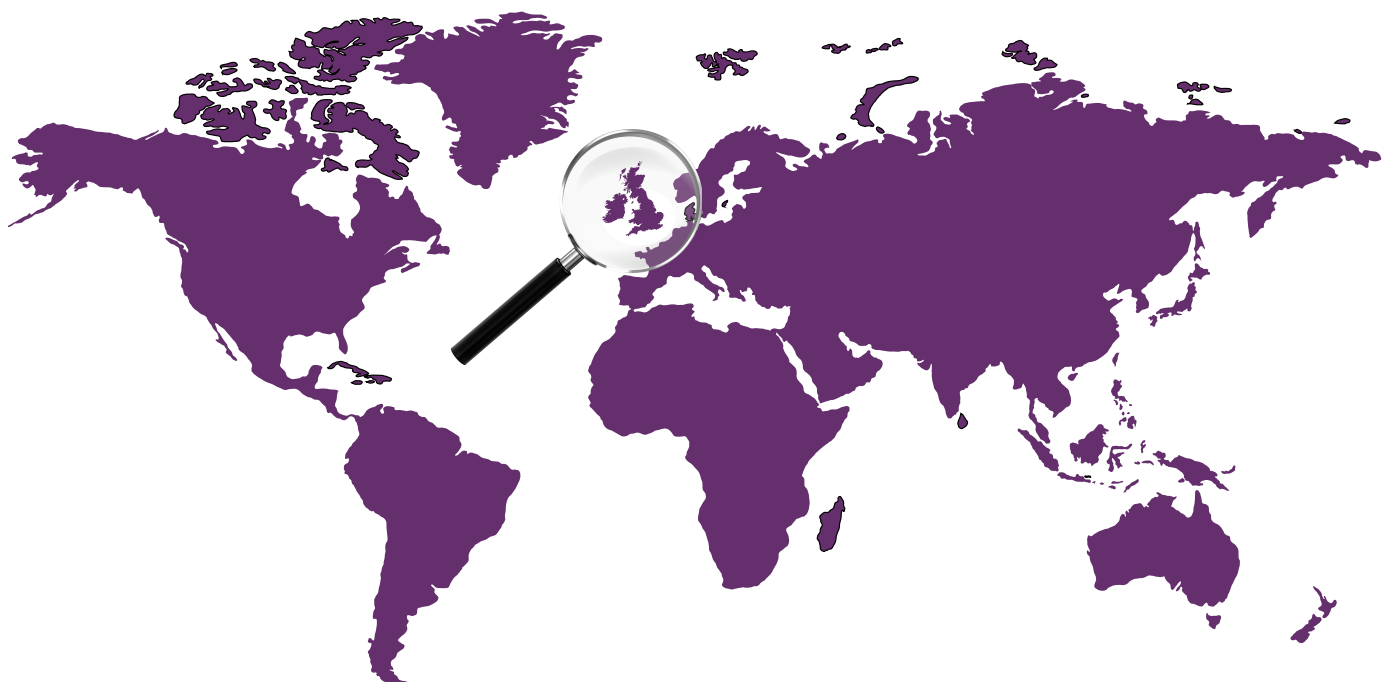

CPD

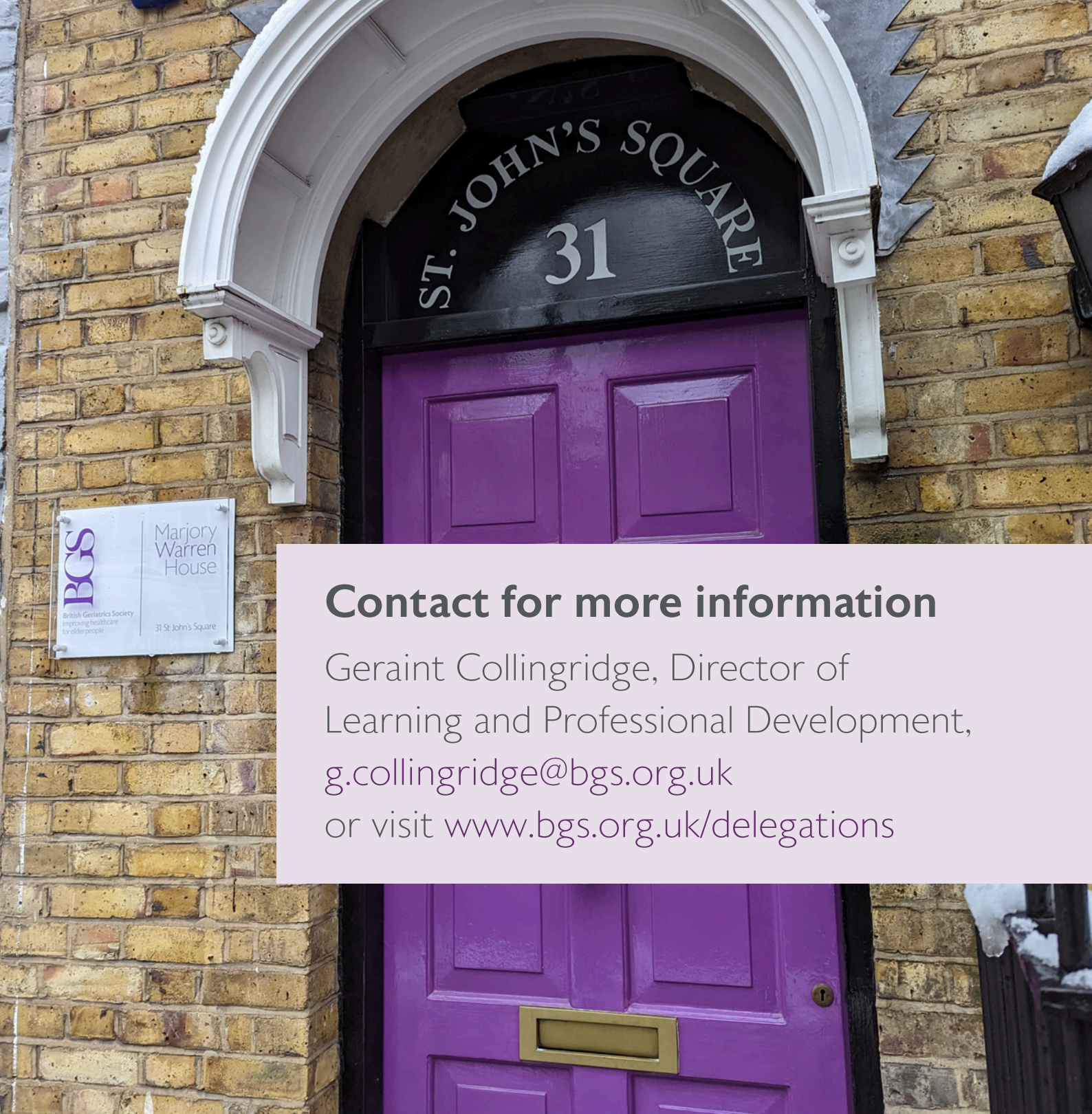
Obtain 25 hours of external CPD.
